Thankyou for working in partnership with WA Health to develop a Strategic Investment Proposal (SIP) for a WA Comprehensive Cancer Centre. I commend the excellent work by all parties involved to prepare such a detailed proposal

Consistent with our mutually-agreed decision to split the business case process into two steps, I am satisfied that the Strategic Investment Proposal delivers on its intended purpose of identifying a preferred option to form the basis of a detailed business case

I am pleased to advise that, prior to caretaker coming into effect, I accepted the SIP recommendation that Option 8 be the preferred option

I note that the detailed business case will be prepared based on an indicative funding envelope of \$750 million, with a funding decision on the State Government's proposed \$375 million contribution to be made through the appropriate budget processes following its submission to government

I congratulate the work Perkins and WA Health have done to develop a preferred option capable of delivering a world-class facility with centrally co-located services whilst also supporting cancer care closer to home for Western Australians across metropolitan and regional areas

I encourage the Perkins Institute to update its stakeholders on this important milestone and the next steps and we continue to work towards a better future for cancer patients in Western Australia


Please find attached a letter from Minister Sanderson which you will receive a hard copy of shortly.
